

THE MARVELLOUS MEADOWS PROJECT

WHAT WE'VE BEEN UP TO

61 trees have been planted, including:

- Downy Birch and Goat Willow on the raised ground behind the scrape
- Remaining Downy Birch and Dogwood in the area by the fence

(either prefer or tolerate wet habitats)

- Wetland wildflower and purple loosestrife seeds around the scrape.

Ducks have been spotted in the meadow, but for the time being we need to scare them off to stop them eating the seeds.



Bird surveys are taking place over the next month to hopefully record an increase in species, and be turned into useful signage for students to explore the wildlife in the meadow.

Thank you to everyone who took part in the tree competition, winners will be announced after the Easter holidays.
